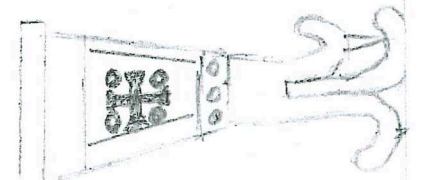




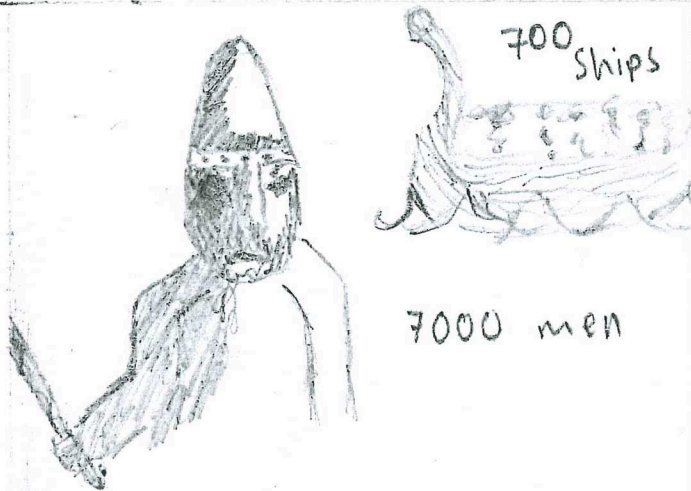
Harold the 2nd was crowned king in January 1066.



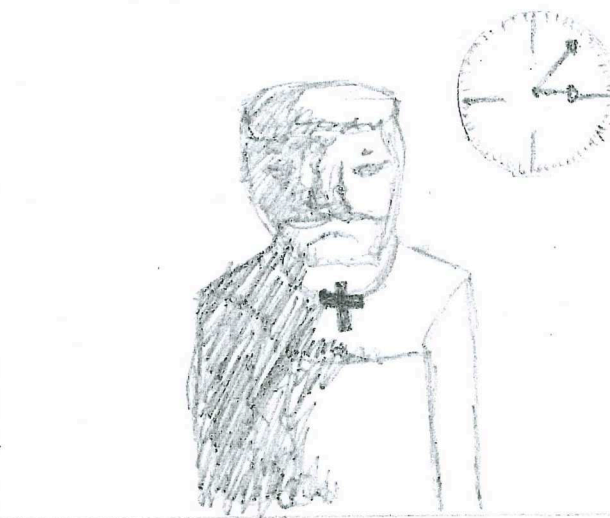
William, duke of Normandy landed in Sussex, England



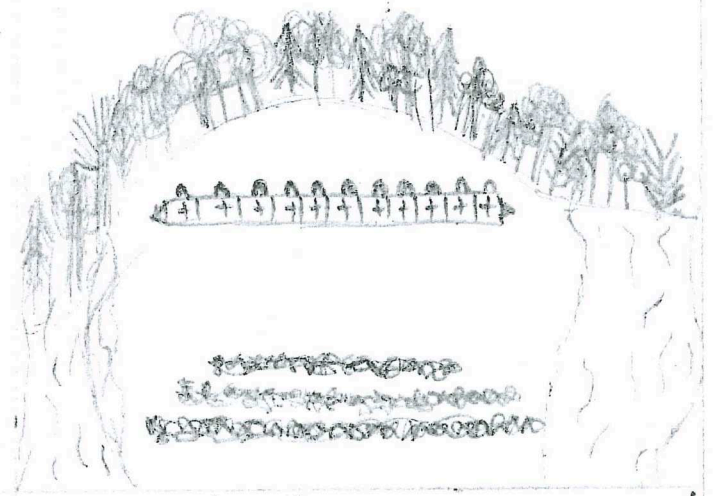
William was angry. He planned his invasion with the popes blessing.



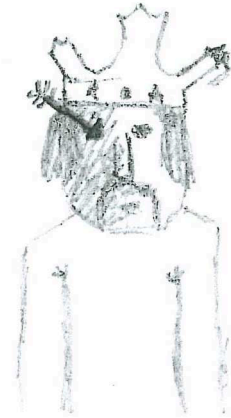
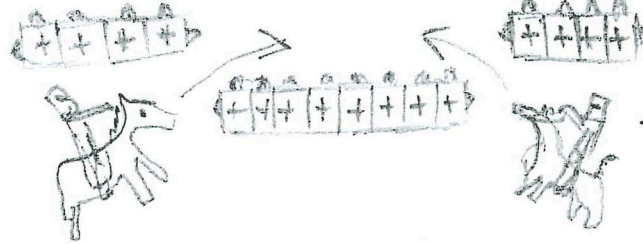
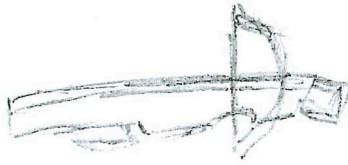
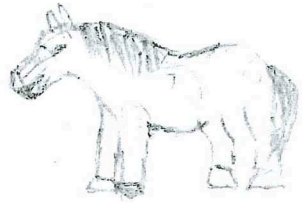
William had an incredibly strong army with 7000 men and 700 ships
