Yr 12 historians spent a lesson analysing an article about Anne Boleyn by the historian Suzannah Lipscombe, we broke down each paragraph and summarised with a key word and a bullet point to hone note taking techniques and pin point arguments.

They then created world walls of their opinions about Anne Boleyn using the website mentimeter.com to answer the questions and then a google poll to determine whether she, Henry VIII or Cromwell was the cause of her fall. There were some who thought Anne's actions herself were attempting to reach above the traditional role of Queen and therefore were "silly". Further reading and viewing on Anne Boleyn can develop the view of what differences of expectation between the sexes might look like in the Tudor period.
